

As we gather this morning, we do so in the name of Jesus Christ and by the power of His Holy Spirit to worship our great God. May you be filled with awe as we enter his presence together. Welcome to worship!

Having been invited to lead the congregation in worship for 3 Sundays in a row, I have developed a broad theme which can be captured as follows: *Exalted to the highest heaven as our Lord and King* (June 1, Ascension Sunday), *Christ rules within our hearts by his Holy Spirit as we walk by faith* (June 8, Pentecost Sunday), *Awaiting the glory that is to be revealed when Christ comes again to make all things new* (June 15). Thus, last week we reflected upon Christ's ascension and our need to reset our spiritual GPS (life orientation), so that we do not lose sight of Christ's return in glory. Today is Pentecost Sunday. And so we consider the live-giving Breath of God by which Christ rules us within our hearts, and by which we walk by faith and are hope-filled and assured of our own physical resurrection from the dead. Next week, I seek to ponder with you the Scripture's depiction of the glory of Christ as seen in His transfiguration and in our own physical resurrection living eternally with Christ when he comes again. **~Dr. Jack Van Marion**
