

These are the words of the crowd that welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem the week of his crucifixion. We still come today and gather in the name of the Lord to worship our triumphant King. Hosanna!

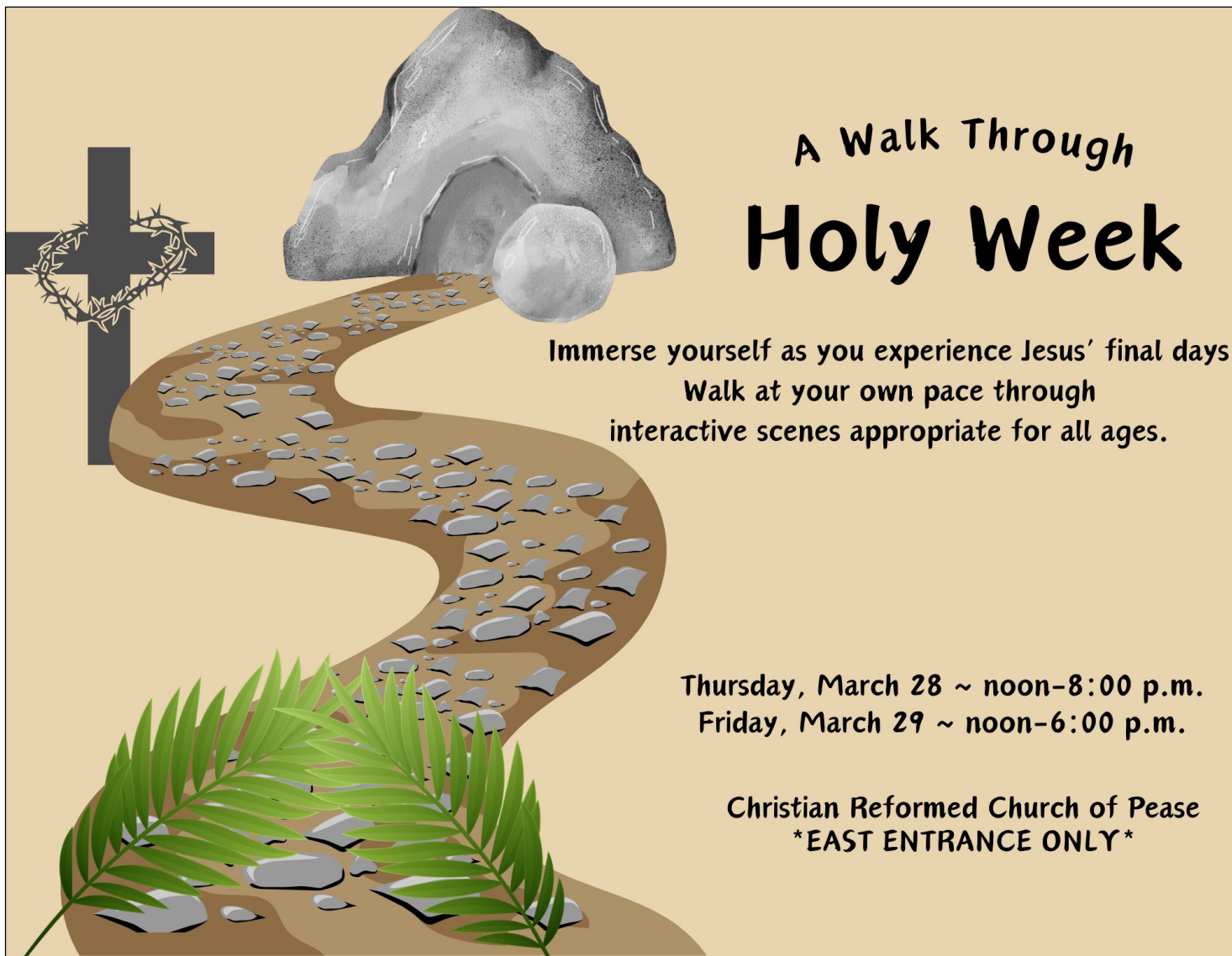
