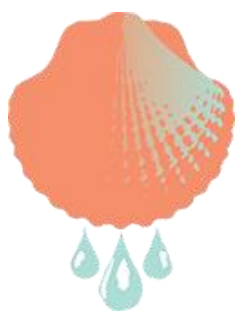
"Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess."

The seashell and the teardrops are traditional symbols used to remind us of Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River long ago. The droplets are blue, symbolizing water, and the washing away of our sins. Three droplets are used to symbolize the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
